## OIL PAINTING

Includes encaustic

## ACRYLIC PAINTING & MIXED MEDIA

## WATERCOLOUR

Includes watercolour paint  
& watercolour pencils

## DRAWING & PRINTMAKING

Drawing includes pen, brush, ink, pencils, charcoals & pastels.

Printmaking includes intaglio, lithography,  
silkscreen, relief, & monoprint.

## DIGITAL ART & PHOTOGRAPHY

Includes paint-enhanced  
photography

## FIBRE ART

Includes weaving, batik,  
quilting, knitting, needlework  
& soft sculpture.

## 3D ART: CATEGORY 1

Jewellery, stained glass, basketry,  
leather craft, beading & tufting.

## 3D ART: CATEGORY 2

Stone, wood, clay, metal. Cermaic  
molds must be made by the artist.

## YOUTH AGE 9-12

Includes all art disciplines noted  
above. A total of three prizes  
will be awarded (1st, 2nd, 3rd)

## YOUTH AGE 13-17

Includes all art disciplines noted

## SPECIAL CATEGORY: LORE

## SUBMITTED ARTWORK MUST BE ORIGINAL WORKS

Artists who work from  
photographs must have taken  
the photo or have permission  
from the photographer to use  
the image. We do not allow the  
use of commercial kits,  
standardized designs, or  
AI generative tools  
for any entry.



## SALES

Artists must clearly state whether artwork is for sale by marking a sale price on the entry form and on the information tag. The NJAS organizers will retain a 20% commission. A cheque will be mailed to the artists after the close of the show.



## INSURANCE

The NJAS Committee assumes no responsibility for any loss, damage, or injury to any entries and exhibits. The artist is responsible for insuring their work while in transit and while the work is stored and on display.



NJAS is open to artists who permanently reside in Northern Manitoba (north of the 53rd parallel), including Creighton, SK and Denare Beach, SK.



Artists are allowed a maximum of six (6) entries per person. Limit of three (3) entries per category.



All work must be original and completed since June 1, 2024 and not be previously juried. Commercial kits, patterns, or artwork produced using generative AI are NOT eligible.



Special Theme Category entries must be indicated on the artist's online entry form.



Size of 2D work is limited to 50"x50"



3D work cannot weigh more than one person can reasonably be expected to lift.



All entries must be complete, properly mounted, and ready for display. If required, special instructions for display must be provided (if a special display device is required, the artist must provide it). Youth entries may be unframed.



Hanging devices must be securely attached to your artwork. NO SAWTOOTH HANGERS.



Works that fail to meet these conditions will not be accepted.



The jurors reserve the right to reassign work from one category to another. The jurors' decision is final.



Honourable Mention awards are given at the jurors' discretion.



Artwork displayed will be at the discretion of the committee.

# HOW TO SUBMIT YOUR ART

**1** Fill out your online submission form.

**2** Pay your entry fees

**3** Prepare your shipping labels

All artwork, packaging, and shipping materials must be CLEARLY labeled. Label templates and instructions can be found at [northernjuriedartshow.ca](http://northernjuriedartshow.ca)

**4** Package your artwork for transportation

Artists are responsible for securely packaging their entries in a sturdy container or crate. Supplied packaging will be reused for the return of artwork.

Please take great care packing your artwork as it will be handled numerous times. Wrap your work securely inside your container with bubble wrap or foam and tape. Include instructions to repack. **DO NOT use styrofoam peanuts.**



**5** Drop off your art at your local depot for FREE SHIPPING.

Entries received from a depot will be returned to the same depot. Shipping courtesy of Gardewine North.
